Steinway Artist Barbara Geary, born in Chicago but a Tulsan since early childhood, holds a master’s degree in piano performance from the University of Indiana and specializes in narrated concerts: Lisztomania, From Paris With Love, Gottschalk Gala, Gottschalk to Gershwin: The Ragtime Connection, all of which join music with the humanities. Ms. Geary has performed in all 77 Oklahoma Counties and was named Oklahoma Musician of the Year 2000. She has also been heard throughout the United States, Western Europe, Canada and Mexico, and aboard the QE2 transatlantic liner. Ms. Geary’s performance of the music of Franz Liszt has been described as “compelling” (London) and having “virtuosic allure” (St. Louis). Ms. Geary is a long standing performing member of Hyechka Club of Tulsa.
